Te Motu Syrah 2009

Beautifully soft and smooth with spice, liquorice, pepper and some underlying savoury notes. We made only one barrel of this Syrah and have held it back until we think its drinking exceptionally. This wine will continue to age for another 5-8 years.

Te Motu *Kokoro* 2013

Named for the head of Te Motu's founding family Terry Dunleavy, *Kokoro* means *the patriarch* in Maori and *the heart of things* in Japanese. A Merlot-dominant blend with Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Syrah and hand-harvested from low-yielding vines. A bold wine with mocha, dark rich fruits, spice and cassis with fantastic aging potential from the stand out vintage of 2013.

Te Motu *Tipua* 2013

In Maori legend Tipua is a shape-shifter. So too is our Tipua wine, only made in an exceptional vintage and only then when one variety from that vintage really shines. Our 2013 Tipua is 100% Cabernet Franc, an aromatic nose of violets and red currants leads onto a palate full of cedar, ripe cherries, white pepper and rich, ripe tannins.

The flagship wine of the estate, Te Motu is a Cabernet Sauvignon dominant blend with Merlot and Cabernet Franc hand harvested from low-yielding vines, aged for a minimum of five years before release.

Te Motu 2012

A nose full of ripe dark-red and black berried fruits, blackcurrants and cassis, with fragrant red fruits and oak. Medium-full bodied, beautifully weighted and rounded with a palate of savoury dark-red berry fruit along with dark plums, dried herbs, earth and funky game. Fine-grained tannin structure yet gentle and elegant with a powerful finish.

A true wine family with values as strong and deep-rooted as the vines they have nurtured, the Dunleavy name has been synonymous with quality and longevity since 1989.

Dunleavy Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2016

Citrus and mineral notes mingle with a background of fresh stone fruits.

The rich palate is balanced by zesty acidity.

Dunleavy Marlborough Riesling 2016

Fresh lime and citrus characters following through with some floral notes.

Lively acidity gives a crisp structure to the wine with a long finish.

Dunleavy 'The Lone' Flora 2017

The Lone Flora is a very rare wine. Not only are the total plantings of Flora in NZ just 3 hectares, but the small site on Waiheke was completely pulled out following the 2017 harvest. A cross of Gewürztraminer and Semillon this wine has a nose of tangerine, lime and a tropical sweetness. Citrus and pear on the palate with fantastic weight and roundness leave a long, fresh and lingering finish.

Dunleavy 'The Shed' Rose 2017

The Dunleavy 'The Shed' Rosé 2017 is 100% Merlot with a peach, watermelon, strawberries and cream on the nose.

Made in a province style the palate is light and fresh yet nicely weighted and balanced with mandarin, strawberries and cream on the palate.

Dunleavy 'The Nectar' late harvest Rose 2017

Made from raisined Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, 'The Nectar' is our first late harvest sweet wine made at Te Motu. A rich nose of quince, fig, dried fruit, orange zest, honey and raisins. Lusciously sweet and silky on the palate with a crisp fresh acid that leaves you wanting to come back for more.

Dunleavy Cabernet Merlot 2014

A full flavoured, yet elegant red wine with red fruits, spice and a fresh acidity to finish. Flavours of strawberries, dark herbs and cassis with a medium body made for early and easy drinking enjoyment.

Dunleavy 'The Strip' Single Vineyard Cabernet Merlot 2014

A ruby red coloured wine with aromas of red cherries, raspberries, bramble fruits and dried herbs. The palate has great concentration and weight with flavours of red fruits blackberries, and some cedar notes. A silkiness on the palate and fresh acidity leave a long lingering finish.
