<b>Te Motu 'Kokoro' 2013</b>	150
<i>A merlot dominant blend with blueberry, plum, mocha, cedar notes and a rich, full body 95 points by Wine Orbit/95 points by Bob Campbell MW/95 points by Gourmet Traveller</i>	
<b>Te Motu 'Syrah' 2009</b>	175
<i>Only 1 barrel made of this beautiful Syrah. Soft and smooth with spice, liquorice, pepper and savoury notes</i>	
<b>Te Motu 'Tipua' 2013</b>	195
<i>100% Cabernet Franc with a nose of violets and red currants, ripe cherries and cedar 5 stars by Raymond Chan</i>	

**Te Motu flagship wine is a Cabernet Sauvignon dominant blend with Merlot and Cabernet Franc hand harvested from low-yielding vines, aged for a minimum of five years before release.**

<i>A rich red with ripe cherries, blackberries and smoke. Some gamey notes with ripe tannins.</i>

<i>100% Merlot made in Provence-style with strawberries on the nose with a light and fresh finish</i>

- Te Motu 2007** 550
- Our most classic Bordeaux style to date. Elegant and rich with blackcurrant fruit, cassis and dried herbs on the nose. Dark fruit, mint, cedar and earthiness come through on the palate. A very smooth and rich wine with soft tannins and bright acidity will give this wine fantastic longevity.*

- Te Motu 2005** 650
- A full and voluminous nose with ripe blackberry, plum and curranty aromas, harmoniously entwined with earth and savoury secondary undergrowth and dried herb nuances. Fine grained tannins with flavours of cassis, herbs, plums and spice along with earth and game. A rich, full body with great concentration of flavours. This wine can age well into 2022+*

- Te Motu 2000** 450
- A fullsome and robust blend with a full bouquet of blackberry and plum with secondary notes of earth, herbs and game. On the palate smoke and toasty oak with dark red and black berried fruits, cassis and typical game and savouriness expected by a wine of this age. Soft in the body and palate but still with lively acidity. Drinking beautifully now.*

- Magnum** 895
- Te Motu 1999** 495
- An elegant wine with soft, smooth mature aromas of dark berry, blackcurrant fruits and savoury cedary notes. Medium-bodied with dried herbs, earth and game elements on the palate. Lively acidity, fine tannins and great depth gives this wine a full and complex mouthfeel*

- Te Motu 1998** 1350
- A supple and elegant wine with attractive sweet fruits and a seductively smooth texture. A developed wine with licorice, prune, dried apricot and toffee along with tertiary flavours of game, savouriness and forest floor. A lovely mature wine showing complex flavours and a long lingering finish.*

- Te Motu 1997** 950
- Garnet in colour with a sweet fragrance on the nose along with secondary aromas of earth, mushroom and forest floor. Cassis and cedary oak on the palate with dried fruits, prunes and dried herbs. A mature wine with exceptional smoothness. A fantastic example of how Waiheke Bordeaux blends can age.*

- Te Motu 1994** 1950
- Only a few bottles remaining from the second vintage ever produced by Te Motu. A very interesting and complex wine with aromas and flavours of earth, game, mushroom and forest floor. Dried herbs, cassis and oak with a touch of vanilla on the palate.*
