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**TE MOTU WINES**

*Named for the head of Te Motu's founding family, Kokoro means 'the patriarch' in Maori and 'the heart of things' in Japanese. A merlot dominant blend with Cabernet Sauvignon, franc, Malbec and Syrah.*

**Te Motu "Kokoro" 2014** 25 95

*A medium ruby red, aromas of red currant, dark cherry and wild berry. The palate is soft and textural with juicy cherry and a hint of spice that lingers long after the last sip.*

**Te Motu "Kokoro" 2013** 185

*The palate has super concentration with silky tannins and integrated acidity.*

*Te Motu flagship wine is a Cabernet Sauvignon dominant blend with Merlot and Cabernet Franc hand harvested from low-yielding vines, aged for a minimum of 5 years before release.*

**Te Motu 2014** 30 140

*Fresh red fruits and dark cassis mingle with dried herbs, spice and toasty oak.*

**Te Motu 2013** 40 165

*Medium-full bodied, very dark, intense aromas of blackcurrants and cassis liqueur.*

**Te Motu 2012** 35 150

*Fragrant red fruits, blackcurrants and cassis with a beautifully weighted and rounded palate*

**Te Motu 2009** 225

*An elegant wine with dark fruit, game, leather and violets. A concentrated palate with savouriness.*

**Dunleavy Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2019** 14 60

*Citrus and mineral notes with a rich palate balanced by zesty acidity.*

**Dunleavy Marlborough Riesling 2016** 14 60

*Dry-style with fresh lime and floral notes*

**Dunleavy "The Shed" Rosé 2019** 15 65

*A light crisp Provence-style rosé with peach, nectarine and mandarin citrus on the nose.*

**Dunleavy 'The Nectar' Late Harvest Rose 2018 (Dessert wine)** 75

*Bright cherry red with strawberry jam, quince, sweet cherries and lively acidity*

**Dunleavy "The Grafter" Syrah 2017** 18 80

*A medium body wine with crisp acidity and lingering tannings. Red cherry and black pepper on the nose, flavors of raspberry vanilla and spice on the palate.*

**Dunleavy "The Strip" Cabernet/Merlot 2016** 16 75

*A medium cherry red colour blossoms into dark cherry, raspberry and floral aromas that intertwine with a slight cedar toast and a subtle underlying smokiness.*

### **Te Motu 2007**

*Our most classic Bordeaux style to date. Elegant and rich with blackcurrant fruit, cassis and dried herbs on the nose. Dark fruit, mint, cedar and earthiness come through on the palate. A very smooth and rich wine with soft tannins and bright acidity will give this wine fantastic longevity.*

### **Te Motu 2005**

650

*A full and voluminous nose with ripe blackberry, plum and curranty aromas, harmoniously entwined with earth and savoury secondary undergrowth and dried herb nuances. Fine grained tannins with flavours of cassis, herbs, plums and spice along with earth and game. A rich, full body with great concentration of flavours. This wine can age well into 2022+*

### **Te Motu 1999**

*An elegant wine with soft, smooth mature aromas of dark berry, blackcurrant fruits and savoury cedary notes. Medium-bodied with dried herbs, earth and game elements on the palate. Lively acidity, fine tannins and great depth gives this wine a full and complex mouthfeel*

### **Te Motu 1998**

*A supple and elegant wine with attractive sweet fruits and a seductively smooth texture. A developed wine with licorice, prune, dried apricot and toffee along with tertiary flavours of game, savouriness and forest floor. A lovely mature wine showing complex flavours and a long lingering finish.*

### **Te Motu 1997**

*Garnet in colour with a sweet fragrance on the nose along with secondary aromas of earth, mushroom and forest floor. Cassis and cedary oak on the palate with dried fruits, prunes and dried herbs. A mature wine with exceptional smoothness. A fantastic example of how Waiheke Bordeaux blends can age.*
